



Use this checklist to estimate the true cost of Microsoft Business Central for your business.

## 1. Licensing

- Count Essentials users (\$77/user/month after Oct 2025)
- Count Premium users (\$110/user/month after Oct 2025)
- Count Team Member users (\$9/user/month after Oct 2025)
- Count Device licenses (\$44/device/month)

## 2. Implementation

- Estimate users × \$2K–\$4K per user
- Data migration complexity
- Customizations needed
- Integrations (CRM, payroll, eCommerce, EDI)
- Project management and testing hours

## 3. Ongoing Costs

- Annual license renewals (*plan for 10% increase Oct 2025*)
- Partner support retainer (\$10K–\$30K annually)
- Add-ons (*payroll, reporting, EDI, manufacturing*)
- Training refreshers for new employees
- Internal IT and business resource time

## 4. Hidden Costs

- Employee training (*10–15% of project cost*)
- Internal staff time for workshops and testing
- Productivity dip during transition
- Process changes and workflow adjustments
- Testing during Microsoft's bi-annual updates

## 5. Total Cost of Ownership (TCO)

- 3-Year TCO = Implementation + ( $3 \times$  annual licenses + support + add-ons)
- 5-Year TCO = Implementation + ( $5 \times$  annual licenses + support + add-ons)
- Add 15–25% buffer for scope creep or unexpected needs

## 6. Final Step

- Once you've filled this out, you'll have a realistic view of what Business Central will cost to own and operate for your business.
